


## Using the Game Reporting Form

**8** Submit Reset

1. Select the date of the game from the drop down boxes
2. Enter the name of your parent volunteer who scored or ran the clock
3. Use the drop down boxes to choose your and your opponents names
4. Enter the scores
5. Enter any technical fouls issued to your team or to the opposition. If there were none then enter 0. Procedural technical fouls are those issued for a technical breach of the rules (e.g. 6 players on the court)
6. Specify a PCA rating for the opposition coach. This reflects your assessment of their sportsmanship. Provide a score on a scale of 1 for low, 10 for high.
7. Use the comments box to report any issues you want raised about any aspect of the game or the facilities. These may be complaints or praise. Include details of technical fouls.
8. When you filled out all the fields click on the submit button.
